Via Kingston  
Rail from Waterloo to Kingston

Walking from Kingston Railway Station (approx 10 min)  
Exit station and follow Clarence Street (down the right-hand side of The Rotunda/Cinema) and continue past the telephone-box sculpture by artist David Mach on your left. Keep straight on, crossing the main roads at Fairfield North, Kingston Museum will be on your left on Wheatfield Way. Ahead you will see Fairfield Park. Cross the road to the Park and take Fairfield West, walking anti-clockwise around the park and onto Fairfield South. Then take the second right-hand exit down Mill Street straight to the Stanley Picker Gallery.

then bus from Clarendon Road to  
County Hall, Penrhyn Rd and 3 minute walk
